ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible to receive the Brad Jenkins Memorial Scholarship, the student applicant or their parent must be 1) a member in good standing of Teamsters Local 120; 2) a member on lay-off status with a valid withdrawal card and recall rights, who was in good standing with Teamsters Local 120 at the time of the lay-off; or 3) a retired, disabled, or deceased member of Teamsters Local 120 who was in good standing with Teamsters Local 120 at the time of their retirement, disablement, or death. Officers, agents, and staff of Teamsters Local 120, or their children, are not eligible to receive a scholarship.

Fully completed applications must be received by April 30. Late and/or incomplete applications will be disqualified.

Winners will be chosen at random, by lot, in May, and will be notified of their selection by mail. Only winners will be notified.

Winners of the Brad Jenkins Memorial Scholarship will receive a \$1,000.00 (One Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) scholarship for the academic year immediately following the drawing. The total number of winners is determined annually, based upon available funds.

Enrollment in a post-secondary educational institution must be verified before scholarship funds will be dispersed. The scholarship will be made payable to the educational institution.

Winners will be formally recognized at their area General Membership Meetings in May. Winners are asked to attend their area meeting in May, if possible.

Failure to respond to the notification letter, appear at the general membership meeting, and/or enroll in a post-secondary educational institution will result in forfeiture of the scholarship funds.
